**The museum tour** at the Addison Gallery will focus on the traveling exhibit “Revolution of the Eye: Modern Art and the Birth of American Television.” In short, it links many of the trends in modern art in the 1950’s and 1960’s which rapidly became incorporated into the look and feel of television during those decades of our lives. We’ll have a docent led tour of the exhibit, with time to explore the many short videos and related text throughout this extensive seven room installation. The route will take from 45 minutes to an hour over a broad well-maintained trail with some rolling terrain. Virtually the entire route is shaded.
