Julia Glass is the author of the novels *A House Among the Trees*, *And the Dark Sacred Night*, *The Widower's Tale*, *The Whole World Over*, and the National Book Award–winning *Three Junes*, as well as the Kindle Single “Chairs in the Rafters.” Her third book, *I See You Everywhere*, a collection of linked stories, won the 2009 SUNY John Gardner Fiction Award. She has also won fellowships from the National Endowment for the Arts, the New York Foundation for the Arts, and the Radcliffe Institute for Advanced Study.

She is a cofounder of Twenty Summers, a nonprofit arts-and-culture festival in Provincetown, Mass., and a Senior Distinguished Writer in Residence at Emerson College. With equal enthusiasm but less talent, she plays badminton year-round. Their second son having recently departed for college, Julia and her husband share their old house in Marblehead with a pair of very noisy Cardigan corgis.
